

List of other methods that have been examined in terms of their use in the sustainable urban regeneration, but not included in the LUDA database:

- Assessing the Sustainability of Societal initiatives and Proposed Agendas for Change (ASSIPAC)
- BRE Environmental Management Toolkits
- Contingent Valuation Method (CVM)
- Diamond of the Quality of Life
- Hedonic Analysis
- Indicator Impact model (INDI)
- Integrated Sustainable Cities Assessment Method (ISCAM)
- Meta Regression Analysis
- System for Planning and Research in Towns and Cities for Urban Sustainability (SPARTACUS)
- System Dynamic Approach

These methods were taken account of in the preliminary master list of 44 methods applicable to urban regeneration. However, a series of consultation exercises resulted in prioritising methods considering:

- The level of knowledge about the methods and techniques among the research partners participating in the LUDA project. The methods and techniques that only a few or none experts had knowledge about were put aside.
- Which methods and techniques are the best used to address the important issues that drive the rehabilitation process. These key issues, affecting four or more of the case-study cities, were land use, housing, access to employment and environmental problems. As a result, the final list of methods and techniques listed in the database is slightly biased towards these matters.
